

Terms of use

Singletrail Großarl

1. Operating times. The opening times of the Singletrail Großarl: Friday to Monday from 10 am to 5 pm, as long as the 8er Hochbrand cable car is in operation. Please double check, before going on the track, that the Singletrail is opened. Opening status at www.grossarlital.info/biketrail. Using the trail when it's closed is strictly forbidden! The Singletrail can only be used in conjunction with a summe biketicket of the Großarler mountain railways valid for this day.

2. Protective equipment. Everybody must wear suitable protective gear. This consists at least of helmets and gloves. Breast armor as well as protectors on elbows and legs increase your personal protection.

3. Trails. Only the marked Singletrail route is allowed to go from the top to the bottom. The use of unmarked routes as well as a branch to the forest paths is forbidden!

4. Consideration to other cyclists. Each cyclist must behave in such a way that he does not endanger or harm any other person.

5. Control of speed and riding. Every rider must keep the path in sight! He/she has to adjust the speed and riding style accordingly to the terrain and weather conditions, as well as to the traffic density on the trails. The trails lead through technically challenging terrain, which requires perfect control over the bike and technical riding skills. The route leads through forests and through farmland. Take care of wildlife and cattle. Be aware of Alpine dangers!

6. Line Choice. The biker approaching from behind has to choose a line which doesn't put bikers in front of him/her in danger.

7. Overtaking. You may overtake from above, on the right side or on the left side, but only if you keep enough distance between yourself and the rider being overtaken for him to have enough room for any movements.

8. Stop, walk and hike. It is forbidden for any rider to stop at a narrow or unclear place without a need. A rider must leave such a place as soon as possible. It is forbidden to walk, hike or climb uphill. The route crosses with hiking trails.

9. Road Traffic Regulations (StVO) must be obeyed
When using public roads, make sure that the bikes meet the requirements of the StVO road traffic regulations according to Austrian law.

10. Read the Signs. Every rider must read the markings, signs and signals. Particular attention must be paid at crossings (STOP by all means!). If your bike does not meet the requirements of the StVO road traffic regulations, you must get off your bike and push it to cross a public street.

11. Help. In case of an accident, every rider is obliged to provide assistance; we recommend that you always carry a mobile phone with you.

12. Identity Requirements. In case of an accident, every rider, whether witness or person involved, responsible or not, must be able to identify themselves.

13. Closed tracks. In the case of a closed track riding is absolutely forbidden.

14. Environment.

Please pay attention to the environment. Take the waste and dispose of it in the designated areas. Animals and plants is given appropriate respect. Avoid noise. Before entering the paved road of the „Guterweg Rodlberg“ and before entering the cableway system, please free the bike from dirt at the washing area at the end of the biketrail.

15. Photographing and filming.

Photographing and filming is forbidden because of safety reasons. In the resting places along the route, the photographing and filming is permitted for non-commercial purposes.

16. Riding the tracks is at your own risk.

The track is „easy“ (according to the official singletrail category). Nevertheless, the use of the track needs an advanced riding level. Children under 12 years of age are allowed to use the Singletrail Großarl only if accompanied by an authorized supervisor. The instructions of the staff must be followed!

The conditions of carriage of the Großarler Bergbahnen GesmbH & Co KG must be followed. In case of non-compliance with the conditions of use, the lift card can be withdrawn.

The operator is excluded from any liability.
