Terms of Use – Singletrail Großarlal

1. Operating Hours

The Singletrail Großarlal is open during the official operating hours of the Panoramabahn Großarlal (as posted). Please check whether the trail is open before using it. Opening status available at: www.grossarlal.info/biketrial. Riding outside the official opening hours is strictly prohibited! Access is only permitted with a valid summer bike ticket for the Großarlal mountain lifts for that day.

2. Protective Equipment

All riders must wear appropriate protective gear. This includes at minimum a helmet and gloves. Chest protectors, as well as elbow, leg, and back protectors, are strongly recommended for additional safety.

3. Trails

Only designated singletrail routes may be used, and only in the downhill direction. Use of unmarked trails or diversion onto forest roads is prohibited!

4. Consideration

Every cyclist must ride in a manner that does not endanger or harm others.

5. Control

Riders must maintain visual control at all times. Speed and riding style must match the rider's ability, terrain, weather conditions, and traffic. The surface is uneven and consists of natural materials (soil, roots, rocks), requiring good technical skills and bike control. The trail passes through forests and agricultural meadows. Respect wildlife and grazing livestock. Be aware of alpine hazards.

6. Lane Choice

Overtaking riders must choose a line that does not endanger those in front.

7. Overtaking

Only overtake at sufficiently wide points, from above, right, or left – always keeping a safe distance that allows the overtaken rider enough space to move freely.

8. Stopping, Walking, and Hiking

Stopping in narrow or blind sections without necessity is prohibited. Fallen riders must clear the area quickly. Walking, hiking, or riding uphill on the trail is strictly prohibited. The trail crosses hiking paths – please show appropriate consideration and give hikers the right of way.

9. Road Traffic Regulations

When using public roads at the end of the trail, bikes must comply with road traffic regulations (StVO).

10. Signage

All signage, markings, and signals must be observed. Special caution is required at road crossings (mandatory stop!).

11. Assistance

In the event of an accident, every rider is obligated to provide assistance.

12. Identification

In case of an accident, every rider (witness or participant, responsible or not) must provide their personal details.

13. Trail Closures

If the trail is closed or the Panoramabahn Großarlal is not in operation (off-season), riding is strictly prohibited.

14. Environment

Respect the environment. Take all trash with you and dispose of it properly in the valley. Do not ride off the trail or leave visible tracks. Respect animals and plants, and avoid noise. Before entering the paved "Güterweg Rodlberg" or the cable car station, please clean your bike at the wash station located at the trail's end.

15. Photography and Filming

Taking photos or videos directly on the trail is prohibited for safety reasons. However, photography and filming for non-commercial purposes is allowed at designated rest areas along the route.

16. Ride at Your Own Risk

Although rated "easy" (S1 difficulty according to official singletrail classification), using the trail requires advanced biking skills. Children under 12 may only ride when accompanied by an authorized adult. Instructions from staff must be followed at all times!
